

The European automobile manufacturers' association, ACEA, expect car registrations in the region to shrink by 1% in 2019, revising their previous forecast of 1% growth.



"Aside from the uncertainty due to Brexit and changing macroeconomic conditions, this represents a natural stabilisation of the market", ACEA Secretary General Erik Jonnaert said last week.

ACEA now sees total EU car sales at a little more than 15 million units for this year.
