



Bosch have opened an R&D centre in Shanghai to focus on the development of digital technologies for vehicle cockpits. The centre will mainly develop digital cabin products such as information domain computers, driver and passenger monitoring systems and 5G-V2X vehicle connectivity control units.

It is the third R&D site that Bosch's vehicle multimedia business unit has established in China, following car infotainment R&D centers in Suzhou and Wuhu in east China. While enhancing software development capability to serve customers in China, the center will undertake advance research and innovation for the global auto market, Bosch said.
