

## Lincoln Continental Headlamps Recalled

Ford are recalling nearly 1,900 of their new luxury flagship 2017 Lincoln Continental in the U.S. and Canada for defective front lamp assemblies. The vehicles went on sale in the U.S. last month, with 775 sold in September.

Ford's recall covers 1,826 vehicles in the U.S. and 49 in Canada built between June 14 and Sept. 23 using lamps without the proper lenses to meet Federal requirements for turn signal visibility. The vehicles will be inspected at dealerships and defective assemblies will be replaced with new ones.



The recall is likely to be a costly one; the front combination lamp on the Continental is a very de luxe, high-content full-LED item.
